TO : ALL CONCERNED

SUBJECT : FINALITY OF THE REVOCATION ORDERS

---

This Circular covers corporations registered from 1936 to 2000 whose certificates of registration were revoked by the Commission for failure to comply with the reportorial requirements.

Considering that the Commission has, on several occasions, extended the periods within which the corporations concerned may file petitions to set aside such revocation, the Commission resolved to extend for the last time the period within which such corporations may file their petition in accordance with the following schedule:

Failure to file the said petitions within the periods indicated above shall mean that the orders of revocation can no longer be lifted nor set aside.
