 In case of supplier being declared blacklisted by the GPPB, which among the blacklisting penalties shall prevail? The one year that expired December 31, 2019 or The two (2) year automatic blacklisting acceptance by the errant supplier to the Procuring Entity by virtue of the notarized Bid Securing Declaration no. 2 which stted "I accept that i/we will be automatically disqualified from bidding for any contract with any procuring entity for a period of two (2) years which is still within the reglementary period on the other hand. 	The penalty of automatic blacklisting for two (2) years in all government procurement activities shall be imposed against the blacklisted bidder pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 15-2014 dated June 20, 2014.

- 2. What could be the ensuing penalty for violation in relation to item 3 of the Omnibus Sworn Statement stating that " it is not blacklisted or barred from bidding by the Government of the Philippines or any of its agencies..xxx" if found misrepresented by the affiant.
- In case of misrepresentation by any bidder in any of the projects of the SEC, the penalty of automatic blacklisting for two (2) years in all government procurement activities shall be imposed.

This Bid Bulletin No. 1 shall form an integral part of the Bidding Document.
