

The Auction Committee decided to fully award the new 10-year Treasury Bonds at today's auction. The new 10-year issuance fetched a coupon rate of 2.875%, much lower than the 6.875% coupon for the last new 10-year bond issued in January 2019. The auction attracted total tenders of P59.7 billion, almost twice the P30.0 billion offer. (BTR Press Release)

Aboitiz Power Corporation (AP) lists its PHP 9 billion Series E Fixed Rate Bond Due 2022 and PHP 0.55 Billion Series F Fixed Rate Bonds Due 2025 on PDEx last 6 July 2020, counted as the fourth and last tranche of its PHP 30 billion debt securities program, and is pegged to issue quarterly interest payments at 3.125% and 3.935%, respectively. This 18th listing for 2020 brings the year-to-date total of new listings to PHP 221.05 Billion, pushing the total level of tradable corporate debt instruments to PHP 1.47 Trillion issued by 56 companies, comprising 201 securities.
